## Travel tips and getting to the venue from the airport

There are 2 modes of transportation available when travelling from Prague airport, officially called **Václav Havel Airport Prague (PRG)**, to the city centre of Prague: **Taxi** and **Bus**. Taking a Prague airport taxi is the most convenient and quick option. The ride to the city of Prague costs approximately 27€ (694 CZK) and it takes around 35 minutes. The cheaper alternative is the bus. However, there is no direct bus route from the airport to the downtown area of Prague. Bus tickets cost only 1.20€ (32 CZK) per person and the journey takes about an hour. In case you decide for this option, we suggest this connection (one ticket for that is fine).

- Taking a bus line 119 from Václav Havel airport to Nádraží Veleslavín
- Taking the green metro line (A) to transfer station Můstek
- Taking the yellow line (B) to the final station Vysočanská
